- Students who entered in Fall, 2000 are required to meet the revised requirements above.
- **CPA Examination licensure requires, in addition to a passing score on the exam, a total of 150 credit hours of undergraduate and /or graduate courses. These 150 hours must include at least 33 hours of Accounting courses and 36 hours of Business courses not including MATN 120.**
